 - All artwork MUST remain in the gallery until the end of month or sold. Any and all artwork displayed or hung in the gallery MUST be sold ONLY through the gallery during the duration of its exhibition at the gallery.
 - Artists must be willing for Arts of the Inland to make a print to be put into the City's Time Capsule in November.
- Drop-off/ Receiving: September 2, 3-6pm
 - All artists must fill out and sign the Hanging and Waiver Form and have a W-9 on file with the gallery.
 - We also would like each artist to help during two of our open gallery times.(Thurs.-Sun., 1-5pm)
- Meet the artist event and view the winning art: Friday, September 12,
 5-7pm
- Pickup: September 30, 3-6PM
