Eligibility: Awards will be chosen by a qualified judge. This year's judge is [Cheryl Fausel](#). The show is open to all Arts of the Inland (AOI) members and non-AOI members.

Requirements: Artists may submit a maximum of two pieces of work for this exhibit. Art must have been completed within the last 5 years. Works which have received an award higher than honorable mention in any AOI or Art Council of Southwest Florida (ACSWF) show are not eligible. All work must be original, not a copy of another artist's work, or from a magazine, book or photograph not originally taken by the artist or used without permission from the photographer. Art must not be a giclée, reproduction or produced by AI. Art must be the creation of the artist without physical assistance from another artist or instructor. **Exhibitors are required to gallery sit at least two days while the show is open.** *If they are unable to gallery sit then they will be charged a fee at receiving.* Accepted entries are to remain in the gallery until the show is officially closed unless purchased and removed by a buyer in which case the selling artist shall replace the sold item. The replacement item shall be subject to all terms and conditions of this prospectus. All art is subject to the discretion of the Board.

2D Art and Photography: Oil, watercolor, acrylic, mixed media collage, pen and ink, pencil, charcoal, pastel, glass, textile, metal and photography are accepted mediums. Works must be suitably framed or gallery wrapped with painted, staple free edges. **They must have a wire in the back for hanging.** Framed works larger than 24"x30" must be framed using Plexiglas or acrylic, not regular glass. Works exceeding 48"x48" including framing will count as two works.

3D Art and Sculpture: This art should not exceed 40 pounds in weight and the artist must provide own pedestal/display.

Commission: A commission of 20% of all sales will be donated to AOI. The remaining 80% will be paid to the artist and mailed the following month. All sales including collection of sales tax are conducted by the AOI LaBelle Gallery and Cultural Center.

Awards:

Two possible categories for this show:



1. Photography and Digital Art
2. Other Fine Art

*There will need to be at least 9 artists in each category to have this division in judging. If there are not enough to make the 2 divisions then all will be judged together.

Awards for each categories

1st Place - \$200, 2nd Place - \$150, 3rd Place - \$100, Honorable Mention 1,2,3

One Piece will be awarded Best of Show - \$300

People's Choice will be awarded at the end of the month - \$50.

Only one award may be given to an individual with the exception of People's Choice.
